

CITY OF SAVAGE RECREATIONAL FIRE PERMIT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Conditions for Permit:

1. You assume liability for any and all damages and costs that may result from burning done under this permit.
2. You must remain in attendance of fire at all times.
3. Recreational fires are to be no larger than 3 feet in diameter by 3 feet high, contained in a fire pit not taller than 3 feet high, and made of noncombustible materials.
4. Completely extinguish fire when finished.
5. Upon complaint of smoke, you must immediately extinguish fire.
6. Have this permit available upon request of Fire or Police officials.
7. Fires are allowed only when weather conditions permit.

Uniform Fire Code State Statutes

1102.4 **Recreational Fires**

- 1102.4.1 **General.** Recreational fires shall be in accordance with Section 1102.4.
- 1102.4.2 **Location.** Recreational fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure or combustible material unless contained in a barbeque pit. Conditions, which could cause a fire to spread to within 25 feet of a structure, shall be eliminated prior to ignition.
- 1102.4.3 **Fire Extinguishing Equipment.** Buckets, shovels, garden hoses or a fire extinguisher shall be readily available for use at recreational fires.
- 1102.4.4 **Attendance.** Recreational fires shall be constantly attended by a person knowledgeable in the use of fire extinguishing equipment required by Section 1102.4.3. An attendant shall supervise a recreational fire until such fire has been extinguished.
- 1102.4.5 **Discontinuance.** The Chief is authorized to require that recreational fires be immediately discontinued if such fires are determined by the Chief to constitute a hazardous condition.

Intent:

This permit allows families and friends to enjoy a small campfire. Please be considerate of your neighbors. Burn only clean dry wood (burning grass, leaves and paper/trash is illegal). Please be aware of wind direction to avoid smoke blowing into your neighbors' windows.

Any violations of the rules and regulations may result in your permit being revoked for the remainder of the year.

PROHIBITED MATERIALS:

Oils, rubber, plastics, tires and chemically treated materials such as railroad ties, treated lumber, shingles, tar paper, insulation, building materials, clothing, mattresses, carpeting, any solid or hazardous waste.

VIOLATIONS OF THIS PERMIT MAY BE SUBJECT TO CRIMINAL PENALTY AND/OR CIVIL ACTIONS AND THE REVOCATION OF THIS PERMIT.
