SUBJECT: Tree Contractor Registration Requirement  
DATE: December 9, 2004

This notice is to inform you that all professional contractors hired to perform tree maintenance services within the City of Savage shall be registered with the City. The following information shall be provided at the time of registration. Application forms are available at City Hall.

**LIABILITY INSURANCE:** No registration or renewal shall be granted or be effective until the applicant files with the City of Savage proof of a public liability insurance policy covering all operations of such applicant under this section for the sum of \$100,000.00 against liability for bodily injuries to one person from the accident, \$300,000.00 for the injury of two or more persons, and for at least \$200,000.00 against liability for damage or destruction of property. Said policy shall provide that it may be cancelled by the insurer, except that thirty (30) days written notice to the City, and if such insurance is so cancelled and the license shall fail to replace the same with another policy conforming to the provisions of this section, said license shall be automatically suspended until such insurance shall have been replaced.

**WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE:** Each license applicant shall file with the City a certificate of insurance of worker's compensation when such insurance is required by state statute.

**CHEMICAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:** Applicants who propose the use of chemical substances in any activity related to treatment or disease control of trees and shrubs shall file with the City proof that the applicant or an employee of the applicant administering such treatment has been certified by the agronomy division of the State Department of Agriculture as a Commercial Pesticide Applicator.

**FEES:** The filing fee for registration is \$ 35, renewable annually.

## PROOF OF WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE

Minnesota Statute, Section 176.182 (Subdivision 2) requires every state and local licensing agency to withhold the issuance or renewal of a license or permit to operate a business in Minnesota until the applicant presents acceptable evidence of compliance with the Worker's Compensation Insurance coverage requirement. The information required is listed below and will be collected by the licensing agency and put in their file. It will be furnished upon request, to the Department of Labor and Industry to check for compliance with MN Statute 176.181, Subd. 2.

## **TREE CONTRACTOR'S OPERATIONS POLICY**

As of January 1, 2005, all contractors' providing tree related services – public or private – shall be registered with the City of Savage. The following policies shall be adhered to when performing tree services within the City of Savage.

1. Hours of Operation. Normal hours of operation are from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. weekdays, 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. any Saturday or holiday and 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 on Sunday. In the event of a declared emergency, the normal hours of operation may be waived to allow for clean up and removal of storm-damaged trees, and associated debris.
2. Operations on Public Lands. Tree trimming, removal, and injections of any kind shall be prohibited on public lands unless written approval is granted by the City. Trees or woody vegetation on public lands declared to be a nuisance or hazard as defined by ordinance may be abated by a registered contractor with written permission from the City. Any tree related services that may temporarily disrupt traffic or pedestrian movement or cause blockage of a roadway, shall be previously approved by the Public Works Department.
3. Transportation and Disposal of Diseased Wood. Any tree determined to be infected with Dutch elm disease or oak wilt shall be transported and disposed of according to City Ordinance 4-3-18, 19.
4. Notification of Adjacent Property Owners. Contractors that provide tree related services that may impact or disturb adjacent property owners, shall notify the owners of proposed activities when reasonable.
